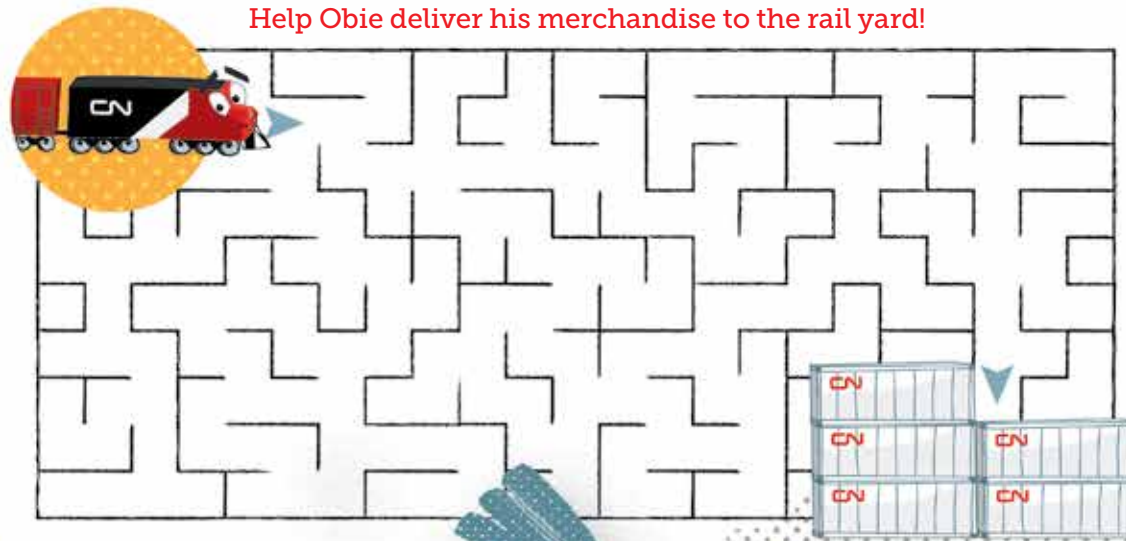
What's behind that badge?

CN makes sure your apples are crisp

At CN, shipping perishable goods is a science and an art. CN's CargoCool services are equipped with a system that detects even the smallest variation in temperature. For example, apples need to be shipped at -1°C to 4°C (30°F to 39°F) and yams need to be shipped at 16°C to 20°C (61°F to 68°F). CargoCool containers are customizable, so we can meet our customer's needs. Shipping smarter also means greener moves. With CargoCool we can power up to 17 refrigerated containers at once, compared to just one by truck. Rail emits four times less greenhouse gases than trucking. So that's very cool!



Did you know?

CN uses the latest technology to change the temperature inside containers remotely so food like milk, cheese and fruit start fresh, stay fresh and arrive fresh.



Pumpkin Head!

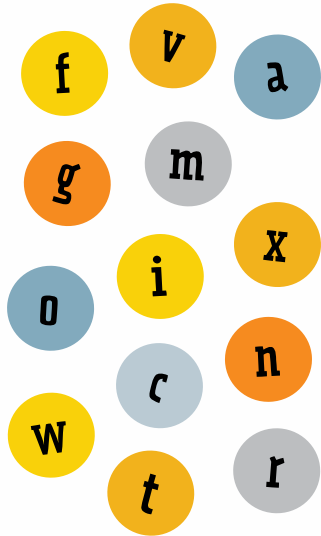
