TOP THREE COMMODITIES



CN owns and operates a fully integrated supply chain that transports iron ore directly from mines to mills entirely with CN ships and trains.

CN's main line runs from our marine bulk facilities in Conneaut, OH, on Lake Erie, where our Great Lakes ships unload iron ore. Our trains then move the iron ore to steel plants in the Pittsburgh area.

In 2021, CN received a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection to help with the purchase of a new innovative Wabtec battery-electric locomotive; a step on the journey toward decarbonizing the rail sector. CN is also working with Progress Rail to test 100% renewable fuels in Pennsylvania, an exciting step toward our goal of reducing carbon emissions.

Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested about US\$200 million to build and maintain a safe and efficient network in Pennsylvania and to support our supply chain partners. The program focused on the maintenance of Great Lakes Fleet vessels and track infrastructure as well as research into alternative propulsion technologies.

Community Investments

In 2023, CN contributed to several Pennsylvania-based organizations, including:

TREE PITTSBURGH Tree Pittsburgh is an environmental non-profit organization dedicated to enhancing community vitality by restoring and protecting the urban forest through tree planting and care, education, advocacy, and land conservation. CN supported the organization's One Tree Per Child program, which encourages every child to plant at least one tree during their time at school.

GREENVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT The Greenville Fire Department (GFD) provides essential emergency and non-emergency services to the residents and visitors of the Borough of Greenville. In addition to providing response to fire-related emergencies, GFD provides emergency medical care, rescue and extrication, and hazardous material mitigation. Other services include a free smoke detector program, stand-by safety services for large public events, fire prevention and code enforcement activities, fire hydrant and vehicle fleet maintenance, fire cause investigation, and traffic signal maintenance. CN's donation is earmarked for a radio system upgrade.
