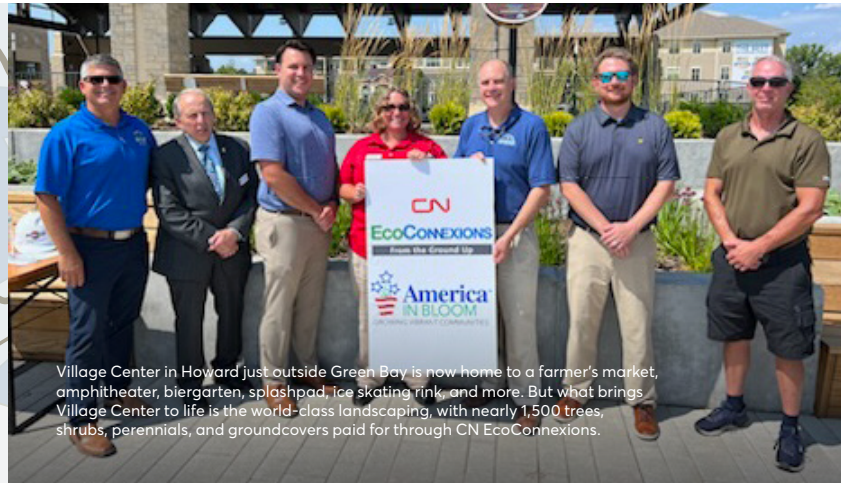
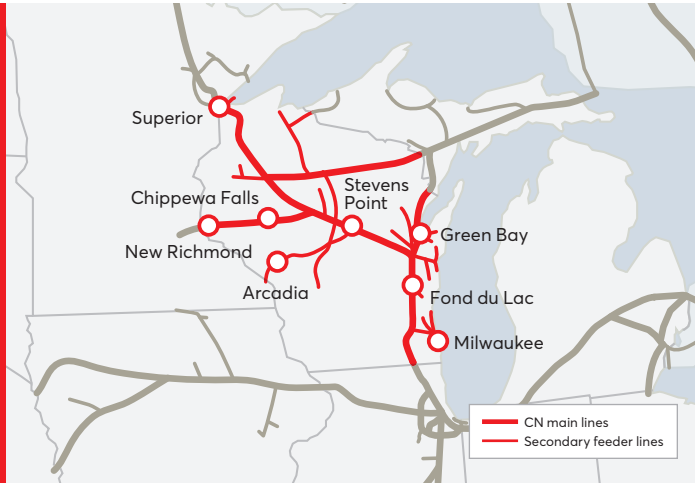

CN serves many local frac sand, forest product and general merchandise customers in Wisconsin, most notably from Milwaukee and Green Bay on Lake Michigan. We also have intermodal terminals in Chippewa Falls and Arcadia. Our two biggest rail facilities in the Badger State are classification yards in Stevens Point and North Fond du Lac. Stevens Point is the heart of CN's North Division and a key location on CN's core route between the U.S.-Canada border and Chicago, IL.

In 2021, we opened an automotive compound for finished vehicles in New Richmond, WI. The facility serves the growing needs of our customers in Minneapolis-Saint Paul and the Upper Midwest.

Network Investments

Over the past decade, CN has invested about US\$1.5 billion to build and maintain a safe and efficient network in Wisconsin and to support our supply chain partners. The program focused on network upgrades, the replacement of rail and ties, plus maintenance of Great Lakes Fleet vessels, bridges, public crossings, culverts, signal systems, and other track infrastructure.

Community Investments

In 2023, CN contributed to several Wisconsin-based organizations, including:

AMERICA IN BLOOM CN EcoConnexions contributed to America in Bloom to promote beautification in Manitowoc and Howard by planting trees and shrubs. Throughout the U.S., America in Bloom and CN completed 13 tree-planting projects in 2023. Together, we have planted more than 70,000 trees, shrubs and perennials along our U.S. network since the beginning of our collaboration in 2014.

FOND DU LAC FESTIVALS CN sponsored several inclusive, family-friendly events that showcase the Fond du Lac community and give back to other non-profit groups and organizations in the area, including Bags Fest, Sturgeon Spectacular, Fondy FallToberFest and Walleye Weekend.

CENTER FOR CHILDHOOD SAFETY The Center for Childhood Safety (CCS) is dedicated to helping families and communities keep children safe from accidental injuries. CCS's mission is to be the leading source of safety education and programming in Northeast Wisconsin. The CN Police Service has had a similar mission for more than 100 years.

NATIONAL RAILROAD MUSEUM The National Railroad Museum inspires lifelong learning by providing dynamic, educational opportunities through the preservation of railroad objects, engaging exhibits, and innovative programs. CN sponsors the museum's Polar Express, a time-honored holiday tradition for people throughout Wisconsin and beyond.

HECKRODT WETLAND RESERVE The Heckrodt Wetland Reserve is a 76-acre urban nature reserve in Menasha with boardwalks and trails through forested wetland, meadows, and open water. Wheelchair- and stroller-friendly, Heckrodt's more than three-mile trail system allows access to the wetland without getting wet feet. Also includes a Nature Center with live animals and indoor/outdoor play areas.
